Hi Lonnie:

Senator Reynolds asked me to have a substitute amendment drafted for LRB 2213. LRB 2213 deals with parental consent for minors to borrow R-rated movies from public libraries. The substitute amendment would require every new applicant for membership privileges at any public library to state whether they allow their minor children (if they have any) to borrow R-rated movies from the library. If the parent does not consent, then the library is prohibited from renting R-rated movies to minors. Let me know if you have any questions.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits a public library from loaning or renting to a minor an "R" rated (restricted) movie unless the library is provided with proof that the minor's parent or guardian consents to the loan or rental.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 43.17 (12) of the statutes is created to read:

4 43.17 (12) ~~A public library may not loan or rent to a minor a movie~~ ^{movies} rated

5 "restricted" under the rating system instituted by the Motion Picture Association of
6 America. If the parent or guardian does not consent, the
7 public library may not loan or rent such movies to those minor
