Subject: Technical Memo on SB 313

In reviewing the provisions of SB 313 in order to prepare the fiscal estimate, we have discovered two items that may need to be amended in order to properly fulfill the bill's possible intent.

1. The bill's repeal of both the Special Education aid lapse requirement and the DHFS supplemental payments was previously accomplished in 2005 Act 25, the 2005-07 biennial budget bill.
2. Given the 2-step nature of the proposed MA SBS payments and differing percentages, it is assumed that the bill may have intended to increase the MA SBS percentage paid to school districts but did not intend to award 100 percent of all current MA SBS claims to school districts, as described in the fiscal estimate. As such, the bill may need to be amended to avoid such a payment situation.
