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

Joe,

Who would be the drafter to work on a bill related to the Biomedical Technology Alliance (BTA)? We put the following budget amendment in the budget bill, however the governor vetoed \$2 million of the funding, leaving only \$500,000 to go to the BTA. Ted would like to draft a bill that provided an additional \$2 million to go to the BTA. We are working on a funding source, but thought I'd ask now who we should work with on this bill draft.

(3k) GRANT FOR BIOMEDICAL TECHNOLOGY ALLIANCE. Notwithstanding section 560.275 of the statutes, as affected by this act, the department of commerce shall, from the appropriations under section 20.143 (1) (c) and (ie) of the statutes, as affected by this act, make a grant of \$2,500,000 in the 2005-06 fiscal year to the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin System to be used by the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee to establish a biomedical technology alliance in southeastern Wisconsin. The department of commerce shall enter into an agreement with the Board of Regents that specifies the uses for the grant proceeds and reporting and auditing requirements.

1 AN ACT ...; relating to: a grant for a biomedical technology alliance in  
2 southeastern Wisconsin.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Under current law, the department of commerce must grant the Board of Regents (Board) of the University of Wisconsin System \$500,000 of general purpose revenue to establish a biomedical technology alliance (BTA) in the southeastern Wisconsin.

This bill grants the Board another \$2,000,000 of general purpose revenue for the BTA; requires the Board to provide private, local, or federal matching funds; allows the general purpose revenue to be used only for research, as opposed to administrative costs; and prohibits the Board from using the money to pay investors, consultants, or nonprofit or economic development organizations.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3 SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.

4 (1) Notwithstanding section 560.61 of the statutes, the department of  
5 commerce shall, from the appropriation under section 20.143 (1) (c) of the statutes,

1 as affected by 2005 Wisconsin Act 25, make a grant of \$2,000,000 in the 2006-07  
 2 fiscal year to the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin System to  
 3 supplement money granted under 2005 Wisconsin Act 25, Section 9108 (3k). No  
 4 moneys may be expended under this subsection unless the Board of Regents secures  
 5 private, local, or federal matching funds that are equal to 100% of the moneys to be  
 6 expended. The department shall ensure that moneys expended under this  
 7 subsection cover only research and not administrative costs and that no moneys are  
 8 expended on investors, consultants, or on nonprofit or economic development  
 9 organizations.
