

Whereas, SPC Tollefson earned his associates degree from the University of Wisconsin-Fond du Lac, before enlisting with the military; and

Whereas, SPC Tollefson had a passion for hockey, football, music, cars, family, and friends; and

Whereas, SPC Tollefson was a member of Holy Family Parish and had a love for the Lord and was a loving son, brother, friend, uncle, and soldier; and

Whereas, SPC Tollefson had a natural ability to connect with people and he had a beautiful smile that could light up a room; and

Whereas, SPC Tollefson made the ultimate sacrifice for his country while fighting for freedom for the citizens of Iraq; and

Whereas, SPC Tollefson was honored with the Bronze Star and the Purple Heart; and

Whereas, SPC Tollefson will always be remembered for his commitment to the U.S. Army and for the cause of freedom, for his love and devotion to his family and friends, and he will never be forgotten; now, therefore, be it
