Whereas, Raymond Heinzen was born in Marshfield on May 11, 1918, and died in Arpin on September 12, 2005; and

Whereas, Raymond Heinzen graduated from McKinley High and attended the University of Wisconsin College of Agriculture; and

Whereas, upon leaving school to take over the family dairy farm, Raymond Heinzen embarked on a career not only of farming, but of civic involvement, serving as clerk of the local school district, a member of the state Board of Vocational and Adult Education, president of the Marshfield Dairymen's Association, and secretary of the Hub Dairy Cooperative; and

Whereas, his sense of civic involvement led Raymond Heinzen to seek election to the Wisconsin Assembly, where he served from the 1961 session through the 1967 session; and

Whereas, he subsequently was elected to the Wisconsin Senate, serving in the 1969 and 1971 sessions; and

Whereas, his interest in education was reflected in his service as chairman of the senate education committee; and

Whereas, his authorship of the university merger legislation in 1971 allows us to view the University of Wisconsin System itself as an ongoing monument to his public life; now, therefore, be it

**Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That** the Wisconsin Legislature salutes the life and public service of Raymond Heinzen, and mourns his passing; and be it further
