

WHEREAS, Captain Hahn joined the Eau Claire Police Department in 1966, and worked his way up through the ranks from animal control to patrol officer to sergeant to lieutenant and ended his career with distinction as captain of administrative services; and

WHEREAS, Captain Hahn trained and prepared extensively for his career graduating from the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire and subsequently from the FBI academy in Quantico, Virginia; and

WHEREAS, Captain Hahn was devoted to serving his community, but was equally devoted to his country, as a military police officer and canine trainer in the United States Army; and
