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

Brief Description of Intent:

This request creates three new appropriations for the Department of Employee Trust Funds:

1. A program revenue appropriation to enable the Department to receive and expend gift and grant monies.
2. A federal program revenue appropriation to enable the Department to receive and expend federal aid dollars.
3. A segregated revenue gifts and grants appropriation to enable the Department to receive and expend gift and grant monies deposited into the Public Employee Trust Fund.

Under s. 40.03 (1) (h), the Employee Trust Funds Board is authorized to accept any gift, grant or bequest for the purpose designated if that purpose is related to the mission of the Public Employee Trust Fund. However, there is no corresponding appropriation designated under Chapter 20 of the statutes to receive or disburse funds per s. 40.03 (1) (h). This request creates a SEG appropriation for this purpose.

Currently, the Department does not have an appropriation under Chapter 20 to receive and expend both federal and non-federal gift and grant dollars. This request creates a federal aids program revenue appropriation and a non-federal gift and grants program revenue appropriation. This will enable the Department to apply and/or receive gifts and grants related to the mission of the Department that are not appropriate to deposit into the Public Employee Trust Fund.

Create s. 20.515 (1) (g) – Gifts and Grants, s. 20.515 (1) (m) – Federal Aid, and s. 20.515 (1) (sr) – Gifts and Grants; Public Employee Trust Fund.
