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

→ This bill changes from annual to continuing a general purpose revenue appropriation ~~to DWD~~ that is used primarily for the administration and benefit costs of Wisconsin Works. The unencumbered balance of an annual appropriation lapses to the fund from which the moneys are appropriated at the end of a fiscal year; continuing appropriation balances do not lapse at the end of a fiscal year or at the end of a biennium and are expendable until fully depleted. ✓

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 SECTION 1. 20.445 (3) (dz) ^X of the statutes is amended to read:
