TOPIC: Increase Bonding Authority for the Harbor Assistance Program (HAP)

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE:

The Department requests an increase of \$3.3 million in General Obligation (GO) bonding authority, s. 20.866(2) (uv) Wis. Stats., for the Harbor Assistance Program (HAP) to continue the program at its traditional funding level. Current GO bonding authority for HAP is \$28 million.

JUSTIFICATION:

The Harbor Assistance Program (HAP) provides financial assistance to the state's harbor communities along the Great Lakes and Mississippi River for projects that maintain or improve waterborne commerce. Port projects typically include dock reconstruction, mooring structure replacement, the construction of facilities to dispose of dredged material, and facilities to accommodate cruise vessels and ferries.

2001 Wisconsin Act 16 directed that rules governing the HAP be amended to accommodate the emerging cruise ship industry on the Great Lakes and Mississippi River as well as facilities serving ferries. In addition, 2003 Wisconsin Act 208 expanded HAP eligibility to include privately-owned port facilities.

Traditionally, the program has been funded at the \$4 million level over the biennium; \$1 million from the transportation fund and \$3 million in GO bonding with transportation fund debt service. This request would increase the traditional level of funding to \$3.3 million in GO bonding over the biennium to address expanded eligibility for the program created by 2001 Wisconsin Act 16 and 2003 Wisconsin Act 208.

We received this new request, BB0465, which looks a lot like BB0378 (LRB-1557). I can't tell whether this request is intended to replace BB0378 or to be a second "grant" and in addition to BB0378, i.e. do you want this as a new draft or do you want modifications made to LRB-1557? If the latter, it would be helpful if you could suggest exact changes to LRB-1557, as we are running out of time for repeated modifications..

Also, Peggy previously prepared a bonding authority draft, BB0285 (LRB-1056), that increased bonding authority to \$37,300,000. Is the reference in BB0465 meant to increase this bonding authority an additional \$2.1 million? If so, Peggy will redraft LRB-1056 with a new figure of \$39,400,000.

Please let me know. Thanks. (As I mentioned in my voice mail, we are running our compile at noon today, so accomplishing changes (not to mention new drafts) at this point is a challenge.)
