Please draft the following changes to statutory language for the Wisconsin Technical College System:

1. Delete the statutory provision in s. 38.24(1s)(b) prohibiting technical colleges from charging professional development seminar or workshop fees that exceed the full cost of the seminar or workshop.
2. Amend state statutes under s. 38.24(1s)(b) to clarify that professional development seminars and workshops must have 24 hours or less of instruction.


