

Supplemental Snowmobile Trail Aids

Motion:

Move to direct DNR to make an advance payment of 50% of the unaudited claim for supplemental snowmobile trail aids to counties no later than the September 15th following the August 1st submission of an eligible claim. If the Department's audit of the claim shows that the full claim should not be paid, direct the Department to deduct any unallowable amount from the final audited payment. Provide \$20,000 SEG annually from the snowmobile account of the conservation fund to support limited-term employee staff to assist in completing the annual audits in a timely manner.

Further, require the Department to notify each county that submitted a supplemental snowmobile trail aid request by August 1st of the amount of the final supplemental payment that would be made to the county (including any anticipated proration of eligible costs) from funds available out of combined revenues from the fuel tax transfer and the non-resident trail pass sticker no later than December 1st of that same year.

Note:

Under current law, a county is eligible for supplemental trail aid payments if actual eligible trail maintenance costs exceed the maximum of \$250 and, of the costs incurred, actual trail grooming costs exceed \$130 per mile per year (increasing to \$150 per mile under the bill). Since fiscal year 1991-92, supplemental trail aids have been funded from the 40% multiplier to the snowmobile fuel tax transfer formula. Further, beginning in 2001-02, \$15 from each \$18 non-resident trail pass stickers sold in the prior year is also available for this purpose. If the supplemental aid payable to counties exceeds funding available from the multiplier, the Department may either prorate payments or request that the Joint Committee on Finance take action to provide additional funding from the snowmobile account for supplemental payments.

Counties must apply for supplemental trail aid payments prior to August 1st. Currently payments are made in full after the Department has audited all eligible requests.

It should be noted that under the bill, expenditures to the snowmobile account of the conservation fund exceed anticipated revenues.

Hi Mary -- I have a small change to request on LRB 096/1 (supplemental snowmobile trail aids).

On p. 2, lines 7 and 8, the language directs DNR to **pay** each county the balance owed before Dec. 1. If you refer to the motion, DNR only needs to "**notify** each county that submitted a supplemental snowmobile trail aid request by August 1st of the amount of the final supplemental payment that would be made to the county (including any anticipated proration of eligible costs) from funds available out of combined revenues from the fuel tax transfer and the non-resident trail pass sticker no later than December 1st of that same year. "
