Please note that I replaced the effective date provision with a nonstatutory provision, necessitated by a somewhat peculiar provision in s. 15.07 (1) (c) that generally provides that the fixed term of a board member expires in an odd-numbered year if his or her term is for an even number of years. Because the student's term is two years, if he or she were appointed in 2004, then it's possible one could argue that under s. 15.07 (1) (c) his or her term expires May 1, 2005. The nonstatutory provision ensures that the student would serve at least two years.
