

2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 684

1 AN ACT *to create* 27.01 (16) of the statutes; **relating to:** procedure for the
2 altering of any park entrance at Perrot State Park.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 27.01 (16) of the statutes is created to read:

4 27.01 (16) PROCEDURE REQUIRED FOR ALTERATION OF A PERROT STATE PARK
5 ENTRANCE. (a) The department may not alter any entrance to Perrot State Park after
6 January 1, 2005, that will result in any change in the access to or egress from that
7 state park unless the department receives approval under par. (b) from the town that
8 has jurisdiction over the road on which the entrance is located.

9 (b) The department shall request approval for the alteration of an entrance to
10 Perrot State Park from the town that has jurisdiction over the road on which the

1 entrance is located. The department shall file written notice with the clerk of the
2 town of the department's intent to alter the entrance. The notice shall include a
3 request for the town's approval of the alteration and the reasons for the proposed
4 alteration. The town board shall hold a public hearing within 60 days after receipt
5 of the department's notice. The town board shall provide a class 3 notice of the time
6 and place that the board will consider the department's request. The town's notice
7 shall contain a statement of the entrance that is being considered for alteration, the
8 reasons provided by the department for that alteration, and a scale map of the area
9 around that park entrance. The town board shall hold a public hearing at the time
10 and place stated in the notice before taking any action on the department's request.
11 The department and other interested parties may testify at the hearing. Within 30
12 days after the hearing, the town board shall provide the department with written
13 notification of the board's decision regarding the alteration.
