Regarding your voice mail, I agree that there is a problem.

The instructions for the subs. amend. indicate that the exceptions are based on a California law. However, the California law allows a consumer to authorize release of a report to 1) a specified person or 2) for a specified time period. The substitute amendment allows a consumer to authorize release for a specified time period, and does not allow for release to a specified person.

Do you want to amend the substitute amendment to allow a consumer to authorize release to a specified person?

In the alternative, you could continue to allow releases only for specified time periods, and amend the exception so that it applies to any subsidiary, etc., of a person who obtains the report during the specified time period.
