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

Will the following work for you:

" (2) The joint legislative council [is requested to] shall conduct a comprehensive study of motor vehicle weight limits on the state's highways, including consideration of changes in vehicles that may have made current standards obsolete, changes or innovations in other states, the effect of changes on the condition and cost of maintaining roads and bridges, and the need for exemptions for essential services at certain times of the year. If the joint legislative council convenes a committee to conduct the study, representatives of local government, the department of transportation, [vehicle manufacturers,] the trucking industry, and agricultural producers shall be invited to serve on the committee. [If the joint legislative council conducts the study, the] The joint legislative council] shall report its findings, conclusions, and recommendations to the legislature in the manner provided under section 13.172 (2) of the statutes by January 1, 2007."

Dear Representative Ainsworth:

During recent meetings, the Committee has held hearings on several bills requesting various exemptions or changes to highway weight limits. Most of these changes are being objected to either by the Department of Transportation, local government organizations, or the local agencies that have responsibility for highway maintenance.

We believe that this situation points to a need for a comprehensive review of the state's highway weight limits. Such a review could include such issues as the effect of changes on the condition and cost of maintaining roads, changes in vehicles that may have made current standards obsolete, changes or innovations in other states, and the need for exemptions for essential services at certain times of the year.

Therefore, we ask that the Committee consider requesting that a Legislative Council Study Committee be formed to address this issue in a more comprehensive way. Such a committee could include local government representatives, DOT engineers, vehicle manufacturers, and agricultural producers.

We appreciate your leadership on this important issue. Please feel free to contact us if you have any questions.

By the way, it was initially drafted as a "request" rather than a "directive" for the study per the following provision of our drafting manual and, obviously, subject to your feedback that a directive is what you actually wanted:

"Joint Legislative Council Study. The legislature may request or direct the Joint Legislative Council or an appropriate committee of the council to study a problem. ... Because the council receives many requests for studies and it must prioritize its work, it is preferable to request rather than direct the council to study a problem, unless the requester requests otherwise. "
