TO 2005 SENATE BILL 282

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 1: on lines 1 and 8, delete "20.395 (5) (eq)" and substitute "20.435  
3 (5) (fi)".

4 **2.** Page 2, line 2: delete "20.395 (5) (eq)" and substitute "20.435 (5) (fi)".

5 **3.** Page 2, line 3: delete "341.14 (6r) (b) 9., less \$27,600," and substitute "341.14  
6 (6r) (b) 10.".

7 **4.** Page 2, line 4: on lines 4 and 5, delete "85.109" and substitute "250.16".

8 **5.** Page 2, line 4: after that line insert:

9 "SECTION 1m. 25.40 (1) (a) 22. of the statutes is created to read:

10 25.40 (1) (a) 22. Moneys received under s. 341.14 (6r) (b) 10. that are deposited  
11 into the general fund and credited to the appropriation account under s. 20.435 (5)  
12 (fi).".

13 **6.** Page 2, line 6: delete "85.109" and substitute "250.16".

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**7.** Page 3, line 2: on lines 2 and 25, delete "56" and substitute "57".

**8.** Page 3, line 12: on lines 12 and 13, delete "9" and substitute "10".

**9.** Page 3, line 15: on lines 15, 17 and 22, delete "56" and substitute "57".

**10.** Page 3, line 22: delete "20.395 (5) (eq)" and substitute "20.435 (5) (fi)".

**11.** Page 4, line 1: delete "56" and substitute "57".

**12.** Page 4, line 5: delete lines 5 to 12 and substitute:

"**SECTION 5m.** 341.14 (6r) (fm) 7. of the statutes, as affected by 2005 Wisconsin Act 25, <sup>section 224-715</sup> is amended to read:

341.14 (6r) (fm) 7. After October 1, 1998, additional authorized special groups may only be special groups designated by the department under this paragraph. The authorized special groups enumerated in par. (f) shall be limited solely to those special groups specified under par. (f) on October 1, 1998. This subdivision does not apply to the special groups specified under par. (f) 19m., 54., 55., and 56., and 57."

**13.** Page 4, line 18: on lines 18 and 25, delete "\$27,600" and substitute "\$35,600".

> Please review the attached draft carefully to ensure that it is consistent with your intent. The attached draft implements the instructions provided by DOT to shift certain responsibilities to DHFS and to increase funding. DOT specifically instructed that the dollar figure in bill SECTIONS 6 and 7 of SB 282 be increased but that the dollar figure in SECTION 3 of SB 282 not be increased. The result is that \$8,000 of the balance in the transportation fund will be appropriated for use by DMV in connection with these special plates, and all but \$27,600 of funds received for these special plates will be transferred to the DHFS appropriation.

> ~~In addition to the changes instructed by DOT,~~ the attached amendment <sup>also</sup> "cleans up" the bill with respect to statutory changes occurring in the 2005-07 biennial budget bill.
