Peter,

At last week's hearing on AB 589 (meningitis), Sheldon Wasserman asked me to request an amendment to the bill. The amendment would sunset the new statute created by the bill if DHFS includes meningitis in the school immunization law under s. 252.04(2), Stats. I think either of these approaches would work: (1) say that the new law doesn't apply, but keep it on the books; or (2) actually repeal the new law (with the triggering mechanism being that the DHFS Secretary certifies to the Revisor that meningitis is covered by the school immunization law).

Stephanie, here's the language. Subsection (3) on page 2, line 1, would be renumbered (3)(a), and (3) (b) would read:

(b) If the Department of Health and Family Services promulgates a rule under s. 252.04 (2) that requires vaccinations against meningitis, the secretary of the department shall certify that fact to the revisor of statutes, who shall publish a statement to that effect in the Wisconsin Administrative Register. Paragraph (a) does not apply beginning on the day after the statement is published in the Wisconsin Administrative Register.




