

## 2005 SENATE BILL 329

September 14, 2005 - Introduced by Senators DARLING and PLALE, cosponsored by Representatives RICHARDS, WASSERMAN, HAHN and SHERIDAN. Referred to Committee on Natural Resources and Transportation.

1     **AN ACT to create** 349.13 (1k) of the statutes; **relating to:** the parking of vehicles  
2             on highways.

### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Current law, with certain exceptions, permits state and local highway authorities to prohibit or restrict the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on highways under their jurisdictions. This bill permits a local authority, under certain circumstances, to allow persons whose residences abut a highway, and their guests, and commercial enterprises providing services to these residents to park vehicles on the highway, or portion thereof, abutting the residences, regardless of any prohibitions or time limitations on parking. Further, the bill allows a first class city to set aside 721 parking spaces for persons whose residences are adjacent to a University of Wisconsin System college campus, their guests, and commercial enterprises providing services to these residents, if the college campus creates 721 parking spaces on campus.
