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

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**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT ,
TO 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 875**

AN ACT *to amend* 23.33 (2j) (e); and *to create* 23.33 (2) (dr), 30.52 (3) (ir) and 350.12 (3h) (am) of the statutes; **relating to:** exempting from trail sticker requirements snowmobiles and all-terrain vehicles and providing a temporary registration for snowmobiles, all-terrain vehicles and boats that are used in certain advertisements.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 23.33 (2) (dr) of the statutes is created to read:

~~23.33 (2) (dr) *Registration; advertising; fee.* 1. An all-terrain vehicle that is present in this state and used exclusively as part of an advertisement being made for the manufacturer of the all-terrain vehicle may be registered for a period not to exceed 15 days. There is no fee for the issuance of a registration certificate under this paragraph.~~

~~2. The department shall promulgate rules for the issuance of registration certificates under this paragraph.~~

SECTION 2. 23.33 (2j) (e) of the statutes is amended to read:

~~23.33 (2j) (e) An all-terrain vehicle that is registered under sub. (2) (a) or (dr) or that is exempt from registration under sub. (2) (b) 1., 3., or 4. is exempt from having a nonresident trail pass displayed as required under par. (b). The department may promulgate a rule to exempt all-terrain vehicles that are exempt from registration under sub. (2) (b) 5. from having nonresident trail passes displayed as required under par. (b) or may promulgate a rule to~~

1 exempt owners of such all-terrain vehicles from having to pay any applicable nonresident trail
2 pass fee.

3 SECTION 3. 30.52 (3) (ir) of the statutes is created to read:

4 30.52 (3) (ir) *Certificate of number; advertising.* 1. A boat that is present in this state
5 and used exclusively as part of an advertisement being made for the manufacturer of the boat
6 may be issued a certificate of number for a period not to exceed 15 days. There is no fee for
7 the issuance of a certificate of number under this paragraph.

8 2. The department shall promulgate rules for the issuance of certificates of number
9 under this paragraph.

10 SECTION 4. 350.12 (3h) (am) of the statutes is created to read:

11 350.12 (3h) (am) *Registration; advertising; fee.* 1. A snowmobile that is present in this
12 state and used exclusively as part of an advertisement being made for the manufacturer of the
13 snowmobile may be registered for a period not to exceed 15 days. There is no fee for the
14 issuance of a registration under this paragraph.

15 2. The department shall promulgate rules for the issuance of a registration under this
16 paragraph.
