#### **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

#### **BILL SUMMARY:**

AB 38 changes the penalty for persons who violate operating restrictions while holding an instruction permit or graduated driver's license (GDL). Under the bill, those individuals who violate the restrictions must forfeit \$50 for a first offense and not less than \$50 nor more than \$100 for each subsequent offense. In addition, DOT must provide notice of conviction to any adult sponsor of the person.

#### **ASSUMPTIONS:**

-All drivers, under the age of 18, who are cited for a restriction violation under s. 343.43(1)(d) will be subject to the sponsor notification provision of this bill. This statute includes all restriction violations, such as curfew violations under GDL and violations for not wearing eyeglasses. There is no penalty section of the statute specifically written for violation of instruction permit or GDL restrictions.

#### **COST SUMMARY:**

One time DP development costs = \$36,550

On going Contractual Services (postage) costs = \$917, which can be absorbed.

#### BASIS FOR COST ITEMS:

DP development = 43 days (create a new procedure to monitor violations and check for sponsor) X \$850/day (\$600/day contractor costs + \$250/day CPU testing costs) = \$36,550

Postage/Contractual Services costs = 2492 letters to adult sponsors for those convicted of restriction violations X \$.368/letter = \$917.

#### LOCAL IMPACT

The bill reduces forfeitures for both 1st and subsequent offenses. This will result in a reduction in local revenues, however DOT is unable to predict the precise impact since we are unaware of the volume of 1st vs. subsequent violations.
