Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Bill Summary:

In the event of the death of a person who has preference points and/or a preference category or approvals awarded under the preference selection system, the bill would allow the designee of the deceased person to transfer these points, categories or approvals to any minor. Permits included under the preference selection system include hunters choice deer, bonus deer, bobcat hunting or trapping, otter and fisher trapping, Canada goose hunting, wild turkey hunting, sharp-tailed grouse hunting, Class A bear license, elk hunting, and sturgeon spearing. The request for transfer must be submitted within one year of the person's death. The request shall be submitted on a form provided by the Department.

Fiscal Estimate:

There will be no significant fiscal impact upon the Department. A minimal amount of time will be needed to transfer points in the ALIS database and to close the deceased customer's record. This work will be done as part of the day-to-day contact with customers.
