## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

Under current law, the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board may impose continuing education requirements on licensees either as a part of the disciplinary process to ensure competency or by rule, if necessary to preserve the public health, safety or welfare.

Under this bill, the Examining Board would require licensees to attend a training course that the board designs on recognizing domestic abuse or violence and referring victims of domestic abuse or violence to the appropriate agencies for assistance.

This bill will not have a fiscal effect on the Department of Health and Family Services or county departments of human or social services.
