Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill allows certain persons to submit an affidavit verifying the status of a domestic abuse, sexual assault or stalking victim to support a request by the victim to have a name and address treated confidentially for voter registration purposes.

This bill does not appear to involve the court system in this process, therefore, it will have no fiscal impact on the courts. It may have an impact on the local government unit that is required to maintain a voter registration list.
