Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

If enacted, this bill provides that county development plans and revisions to those plans receive approval of the town boards impacted by the plans.

Local impact will vary depending on the number of towns affected within a given county. Towns will incur additional costs for meetings, including public participation. Counties may incur additional costs to rewrite plans that are not initially approved by the impacted towns.
