<b>Description</b> Prohibiting use of social security numbers on state civil service examinations, prohibiting requests by merchants for customers' social security numbers, requiring notice of unauthorized acquisitions of computerized personal information, posting certain personal information in government records on the Internet and accessing certain public records and employer records containing the social security numbers of individuals, prohibiting a register of deeds from recording certain instruments that contain more than a partial social security number, prohibiting number of credit inquiries as factor in credit reports, granting rule-making authority, and providing penalties		

**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

There are no data by which to estimate the number of additional cases that would be referred to district attorneys offices by law enforcement were this bill to be enacted.

**Long-Range Fiscal Implications**

Unknown. If the bill is enacted, the number of additional cases referred to DA offices based on it should be monitored so as to determine if additional prosecutorial resources are needed.
