Description Voter registration at offices of county clerks and boards of election commissioners					

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This legislation permits any elector to register to vote at the office of the county clerk or the Milwaukee County Board of Election Commissioners. Since all county clerks and the Milwaukee County Board of Election Commissioners will have access to the Statewide Voter Registration System (SVRS) being developed by the State Elections Board (SEB), this will not impose a measurable cost on county government.

Authorized county employees may enter the voter registration information into SVRS once the voter has completed the voter registration card. If the county is not an SVRS provider for the municipality where the voter seeks to register, the form will be forwarded to the appropriate municipality for entry into SVRS.

The time and cost associated with assisting in the completion of the voter registration form, entering the information into SVRS or forwarding it to the appropriate municipality will be dependent on the number of voters who register at the county level. It is not feasible to estimate the number of voters who may avail themselves of this opportunity.
