**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill will have little net impact on the workload of prosecutors. It may increase the workload of the DA office county clerical staff in those counties where the transcribing of now essentially mandatory recorded evidence is will be done in the DA office rather than at the police agency. This responsibility will vary among counties and local police agencies.
