Description Transportation of public school pupils who live outside the school district in which they are enrolled					

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, with certain exceptions, a school district must provide transportation to and from public school for all pupils who reside in the school district two miles or more from the nearest public school they are entitled to attend. This bill provides that if a pupil enrolled in the school district is living outside the school district as the result of a joint custody arrangement, at the request of the pupil's parent or guardian the school district must transport the pupil to and from an agreed-upon location within the school district.

State Fiscal Effect: None.

Local Fiscal Effect: While the bill may help clarify district transportation responsibilities, it is not expected to affect overall transportation costs.
