Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The department estimates that 40,200 pheasant tags would be purchased by individuals who intended to hunt stocked pheasants on public land. There may be issuance fees depending on how the tags are issued and whether or not agent issuance fees would be remitted and what that amount would be. Since these details are not known at this time, at \$10 a piece, if we assume that 40,200 tags are sold, that would equate to \$402,000 in added revenue for pheasant stocking.
