**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

Under current law, a "Class B" license is issued for specific premises and authorizes the sale of intoxicating liquor for consumption on the premises where sold. Current law also imposes a quota on the number of "Class B" licenses that a municipality may issue. The quota on the number of "Class B" licenses is generally determined by a formula based on the number of licenses issued by the municipality and the municipality's population.

This bill increases the quota number of "Class B" licenses, under certain conditions, for municipalities having a population of less than 50,000. The quota number is increased by one license if the municipality's commercial growth increased by \$1,000,000 or more per 1,000 population, as measured over the three calendar years immediately preceding the effective date of the bill. In addition, the quota is increased by one license if the municipality's population increased by less than 500 in the previous year and the municipality's commercial growth increased by \$1,000,000 or more per 1,000 population, as measured over the immediately preceding three calendar years.

In the bill, commercial growth is not defined. Hence, it is not feasible to project the increased quota number of "Class B" licenses for municipalities having a population of less than 50,000 or to estimate the fiscal impact of an increase in the number of "Class B" licenses.
