Note: Due to the delay in the implementation of the 2005-2007 Agreement, a lump sum is paid for all hours in pay status from the effective date(s) stated in the description of the pay adjustment, noted below, through the effective date of the Agreement.

1) FISCAL YEAR INCREASES:

A) FY06: General Wage Adjustment (GWA) of 2% limited to the 06-07 pay range maximum.

Effective June 26, 2005, each employee in pay status on the effective date of the agreement receives a 2% base pay rate increase as a General Wage Adjustment (GWA). Any GWA not received due to reaching or exceeding the 05-06 pay range maximum is paid as an FTE-annualized lump sum.
