



## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AMENDMENT MEMO

**2005 Assembly Bill 399**

**Assembly Amendments  
1, 2 and 3**

*Assembly Bill 399* pertains to involvement of military base commanders with local zoning entities and creates a council on military and state relations. The bill also requires a seller of real estate located within a two-mile radius of a military installation to include this fact as a defect in the real estate disclosure report.

*Assembly Amendment 1* deletes the real estate disclosure provisions of the bill.

*Assembly Amendment 2* inserts a word that was missing from the bill.

*Assembly Amendment 3* provides that the chairperson of the council on military and state relations, created in the bill, is to be elected by the members of the council.

### *Legislative History*

On May 4, 2005, the Assembly Committee on Military Affairs introduced Assembly Amendments 1, 2 and 3 by unanimous consent. The committee adopted the amendments and recommended passage of Assembly Bill 399, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 8; and Noes, 0.
