Under **current law**, most motor vehicles are registered on an annual basis with the Department of Transportation. Motorcycles and certain farm trucks are registered on a biennial basis

Under the substitute amendment, recreational vehicles (i.e., mobile homes) and camping trailers are permitted to be registered on a biennial basis (or with the current annual registration). In short, the substitute amendment creates an optional two-year registration for recreational vehicles and camping trailers only.

Also, the **substitute amendment** provides that the bill first applies to vehicles that are registered on May 1, 2007.

Legislative History

On November 17, 2005, the Assembly Committee on Transportation recommended for adoption Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 by a vote of Ayes, 13; Noes, 0.

The Assembly Committee on Transportation recommended passage of the bill, as amended, by a vote of Ayes, 13; Noes, 0.
