Senate Bill 616 codifies the Uniform Real Property Electronic Recording Act. The bill also creates an electronic recording council made up of various parties interested in the topic of electronic recording. The bill provides that one member on the electronic recording council will represent an association of mortgage bankers.

Senate Amendment 1 deletes the word “mortgage” so that one of the members of the electronic recording council will represent an association of bankers. The general term “bankers” includes mortgage bankers.

Legislative History

On March 6, 2006, the Senate Committee on Judiciary, Privacy and Corrections voted to introduce and adopt Senate Amendment 1 and to recommend passage of Senate Bill 616, as amended, on votes of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0.
