Senate Amendment 1 provides a funding source for any state costs that might be incurred under the proposal. Specifically, it creates a Department of Administration general purpose revenue appropriation to pay judgments and costs incurred by the state under the bill (see page 4, lines 1 to 10 of the bill). No dollar amount is provided in the schedule for this appropriation.

Legislative History

On April 12, 2006, the Senate Committee on Judiciary, Corrections and Privacy introduced Senate Amendment 1 and recommended passage of Senate Bill 641, as amended, on votes of Ayes, 4; Noes, 1.
