Testimony on Assembly Bill 54
Representative Mark Pettis
April 28, 2005**

Members of the committee, thank you for the opportunity to testify on Assembly Bill 54, relating to child abuse, vulnerable adult and harassment injunctions.

I am introducing this bill to change a child abuse injunction, vulnerable adult injunction, or harassment injunction to be effective as soon as the court issues it, as long as the subject was served with the petition and notice of the time for the injunctive hearing. This will make the injunctions similar to current law regarding domestic abuse injunctions.

Currently, a court first holds a hearing to determine whether to issue a temporary restraining order for each petition of an order and later holds a hearing to determine whether to issue an injunction. Temporary restraining orders are effective until the court holds the injunctive hearing. Under current law, if the court issues a child abuse, vulnerable adult, or harassment injunction at the hearing, it is effective once the individual is served with the injunction.

This bill will help to address problem situations where a law enforcement officer may lack the authority to arrest a person who violates the terms of an injunction if the temporary restraining order has expired and if the injunction notice has not been served, such as in the instance of someone not appearing for a court hearing to receive the injunction.
