

Testimony Before the Assembly Committee on Children and Families November 17, 2005 Assembly Bill 826

I want to thank Chairman Kestell for scheduling Assembly Bill 826, the "Asia Jones Bill" for a public hearing. As the co-author of this bill I greatly appreciate the willingness of the Committee to listen to the compelling testimony I am certain you will be hearing today.

As we all know from the news stories of the tragic events of last summer, two year old Asia Jones died last June after the van driver who was entrusted to deliver her safely from her home to her daycare provider failed to make sure she got off the bus after he arrived at the center. Asia was locked in the stifling van for about 8 hours on one of the hottest days of the year and she died of hyperthermia. It was every parent's worst nightmare, entrust the life of your child with someone while you go to work, and have the negligent actions of the person be the cause of the child's death.

While the daycare center's license was revoked, the District Attorney was unable to bring charges against the van driver because there were no written rules regarding drivers removing occupants from their vehicles, therefore he could not demonstrate conscious disregard. No one would be help personally responsible for the tragic death of two year old Asia Jones.

AB 826 will fill that gap in state law and creates a range of penalties similar to reckless homicide if Department of Health and Family Services administrative rules are violated, which relate to the care of a child in the custody of a day care provider. The penalties would apply to all persons responsible for a child's welfare in a day care "from the time the child is placed in the care of that person to the time the child is placed in the care of another person responsible for the child's welfare."

Under this bill, penalties would range from a misdemeanor to a felony depending on the severity of the action. In the case of the death of a child being transported in a day care vehicle due to negligence, a Class G Felony could be imposed which is punishable by a fine up to \$25,000 and/or a maximum of 10 years in prison.

To lose a child in this manner is incomprehensible. For the individual responsible for that death not to be held accountable is unconscionable. For this reason I ask for your support of AB 826.

I thank the committee for your time and consideration of this matter. I am happy to answer any questions Committee members may have.
