As the chair of this committee, I am writing to express my willing to answer any questions you may have before the hearing. At you convenience, I am willing to meet or talk with you.



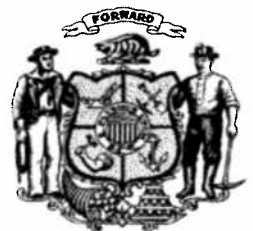
