

Dear Senator Kedzie,

I'm writing to you regarding a couple of bills that are in your committee.

First, thank you for holding a public hearing on December 1st on AB 486 regarding double-crested cormorants. I appreciate you giving me the opportunity to testify and explain how this bird is destroying the habitats of other birds and devastating various fish populations in the Fox River, Green Bay, and Door County areas. I respectfully request that you hold an executive session on this bill in the near future.

Second, AB 365, known as the Safe Intersections Act, passed unanimously in the Assembly Committee on Criminal Justice and Homeland Security, and passed the Assembly Floor on a voice vote. It is a non-controversial bill that will help make our roads safer. AB 365 was referred to your committee on October 26. I respectfully request that you schedule a public hearing and executive session on this bill in the near future so it has enough time to pass the Senate before the floor period ends for this legislative term.
