

Dear Senate Natural Resources and Transportation Committee members,

Attached is an amendment to Assembly Bill 715 that the Committee will consider tomorrow in executive session. The amendment modifies the penalties under the bill for offenses related to handicap parking. Under the amendment, individuals will be subject to a forfeiture of not less than \$50 nor more than \$300 for: lending a special ID card to someone who is not authorized, displaying a special ID card on a vehicle that is not authorized, knowingly providing false information in an application for a special ID card, and knowingly providing false information in support of an application for a special ID card. The amendment also maintains current law with regards to illegally making, altering, reproducing or duplicating a special ID card, which is a forfeiture not less than \$200 nor more than \$500.

Senator Kedzie has spoken to Rep. Krusick, the bill's author, regarding this amendment, and she is amenable to the changes.
