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

This bill requires a health care plan to cover the cost of one wig for each ~~person~~ ^{insured} under the plan who has been diagnosed with cancer if the treatment for the cancer causes the ~~person~~ to lose his or her hair and the ~~person~~ chooses to have a wig. The coverage requirement applies to both individual and group health insurance policies and plans, including health care plans offered by the state, a municipality, or a school district. The coverage may not be subject to any limitations, exclusions, or ^{cost-sharing} provisions that are greater than those that apply generally under the policy or plan. The requirement does not apply to limited benefit plans, such as vision or dental plans, or to policies that cover only certain specified diseases other than cancer.
