AN ACT ...; relating to: authorizing the department of natural resources to issue one-day fishing licenses.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, with certain exceptions including an exception for residents under the age of 16, no person may fish in this state unless the person has a valid approval that authorizes fishing. The Department of Natural Resources (DNR) issues various fishing licenses including resident and nonresident annual fishing licenses, 2-day sports fishing licenses for both residents and nonresidents, 15-day fishing licenses for nonresidents, and 4-day fishing licenses for nonresidents. This bill requires DNR to also issue one-day fishing licenses to residents and nonresidents.

For further information see the state fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

29.219 (2m) ONE-DAY FISHING LICENSE. The department shall issue a resident one-day fishing license, subject to s. 29.024, to any resident who applies for this license.

This bill creates a one-day fishing license for residents and nonresidents. You had asked that the draft provide a fee for residents of \$8 and a fee for nonresidents of \$10. This bill creates a one-day fishing license for residents and nonresidents. You had asked that the draft provide a fee for residents of \$8 and a fee for nonresidents of \$10. You will note that the draft provides for a fee of \$7.25 for residents and \$9.25 for nonresidents. Under current law, hunting and fishing approvals are generally subject to a 75 cent issuing fee. See s. 29.563 (14) (c) 1., stats. I have assumed, therefore, that you wanted this same issuing fee to apply to the one-day fishing licenses created in this draft. Thus, after the addition of issuing fees, the fee for these one-day licenses will be \$8 and \$10 as requested. Please let me know if the fees in the draft are not consistent with your intent.

Also, you may want to consider including a delayed effective date provision in the draft to give DNR sufficient time to establish the new license. If you choose to include such a provision, please let me know and I will redraft accordingly.

Hi Robin,

They didn't think it would take too long but this year they are changing their licensing system and thought it wouldn't be feasible to turn this around in a matter of weeks. My concern with 6 months is if the bill didn't pass until next year we could miss the beginning of next fishing season. My first choice would be to set it to coincide with the beginning of the 2008 Fishing Season. If that isn't real common, we could go with 3 months after the date of enactment. Whichever you think is better we can go with.

Matt:

You asked that I redraft LRB-1422 (one-day fishing licenses) to delay the effective date for next year based on information from DNR. Did DNR suggest a date on which the bill should be made effective? That is, should the date coincide with the start of a particular fishing season? Or do you want to just delay it until January 1, 2008 or later? Alternatively, if DNR gave you an idea of how long it will take to implement the new license (for example, 6 months), the draft can be made effective on the first day of the 6th month after the bill's publication. This is a preferred approach because it is impossible to know exactly when the bill might be enacted.

Also, there is nothing in the draft that would prohibit the issuance of multiple one-day licenses. So I don't think this should be a concern.
