David:

I think that Assistant Attorney General Tom Balistreri's point concerning SECTION 32 of LRB-0176/1 is well taken. I agree that by specifying "private trade, technical, career, distance learning, and degree granting" schools in s. 37.10 (1) you are limiting the EAB's authority to evaluating and approving only those types of schools, notwithstanding the broader definition of "school" in s. 37.01 (6). Accordingly, this redraft deletes the above-quoted language from s. 37.10 (1), but includes that language in s. 37.01 (6) by way of illustration, *i.e.*, "school" means any school that offers a program for a fee, including but not limited to those types of schools.
