Hi Becky----

The omission of the dollar amount is an error in our draft (WLC 0037/2). The earlier draft (WLC 0037/1) had blanks for the appropriation increase for federal and local trail aids. The Special Committee discussed the draft, and decided to put an appropriation increase of \$2,300,000 in each year of the biennium. This is noted on page 4 of the summary of proceedings of the January 4, 2007 meeting. A vote was taken on the draft, with this change, and the draft was approved by a vote of 9 ayes, 0 noes, and 3 absent.

In preparing the final draft, we failed to substitute the committee-approved dollar amount for the blanks in the earlier draft.

Could you please use the amount of \$2,300,000 in each year, and either put this email in the drafting file, or include the substance of this email in a drafter's note?
