Griese Joint Resolution

Relating to: the life and service of Sergeant Louis Griese of the United States Army, who lost his life during Operation Enduring Freedom.

Whereas, on October 31, 2007, Sergeant Louis Griese, of Sturgeon Bay, Wisconsin, a member of the 2nd Battalion, 327th Infantry Regiment, 1st Brigade Combat Team, 101st Airborne Division, died while serving his country in Tikrit, Iraq; and

Whereas, Sergeant Griese provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States of America; and

Whereas, Sergeant Griese is a 1996 graduate of Sturgeon Bay High School. He was described as a quiet student and never got into trouble; his mother said he might have been "the perfect teenager." Griese was fond of the Halloween holiday and it should come as no surprise that he enjoyed the "Halloween" movie series. His mechanical side had him fixing cars and installing stereo equipment; and

Whereas, Sergeant Griese earned many prestigious military awards including the Army Achievement Medal (five times), the Army Good Conduct Medal (three times), the National Defense Service Medal, Iraq Campaign Medal, Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, Noncommissioned Officer Professional Development Ribbon, Army Service Ribbon and the Overseas Service Ribbon; and
