**TOPIC:** License Plate Program - Reissuance

**DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE:**

The Department requests the authority to modify the license plate reissuance period from a 10-year period to administratively select the optimal period to rebase license plates in Wisconsin.

Repeal s. 341.135, Wis. Stats., to eliminate the establishment of a fixed reissuance cycle and to eliminate the requirement for establishing a new plate design for every rebasing cycle.

**JUSTIFICATION:**

1997 Wisconsin Act 237 created s. 341.135 Rebasing registration plates, Wis. Stats. Subsequently, 1999 Wisconsin Act 9 mandated a five-year license plate reissuance cycle for auto, auto-look plates, and some special group plates, and provided additional funding to undertake this initiative. The Department began reissuing auto and light duty trucks plates with a modified plate design in July 2000. Wisconsin's license plate reissuance program was further modified in the following manner: 2001 Wisconsin Act 16 authorized the Department to extend the reissuance cycle to a seven-year cycle, and 2005 Wisconsin Act 25 further extended the reissuance cycle to ten-years.

Due to budget lapse requirements in fiscal years 2002 and 2003, and the permanent base budget reductions in the license plate program in each fiscal year 2004 through 2007, the Department is unable to complete reissuance by the end of fiscal year 2010.

The requested statutory modification will allow the Department to administratively select the optimal time to undertake replacement of license plates, while considering the age and condition of the license plates in Wisconsin's fleet and budgetary considerations.

**TRANSPORTATION**

**DRIVERS AND MOTOR VEHICLES**

Current law requires DOT to establish new designs for most vehicle registration plates every <sup>ten</sup> seven years and to issue the new plates on a rolling basis as vehicle registrations are renewed by the vehicle owners.

This bill eliminates the requirement that DOT establish new designs for registration plates.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

2 SECTION 1. 341.135 of the statutes is repealed.
