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

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



Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

4 funding to assist manufacturers in this state in the adoption of manufacturing

6 with less effort if all of the following apply:

7 (a) The technology-based nonprofit organization submits to the department a
8 plan detailing its proposed expenditures and performance measures related to the
9 project.

10 (b) The secretary approves the plan submitted under par. (a).

11 (2) Beginning with fiscal year 2006-7, the department may not award more
12 than \$750,000 in grants under this section in each fiscal year.

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



This bill authorizes the Department of Commerce *to* make a grant to a technology-based nonprofit organization to assist manufacturers in this state in adopting process improvements that result in the production of more goods of higher quality with less effort. Under the bill, the Department of Commerce may not award more than \$1,500,000 in such grants in a fiscal biennium.
