2007-09 Budget Bill Statutory Language Drafting Request**

Current Language

Current language in s. 49.79 requires custodial and non-custodial parents to cooperate with child support services as a condition of eligibility for FoodShare benefits.

Proposed Change

Delete the requirement that applicants cooperate with child support services in order to be eligible for FoodShare benefits by repealing the pertinent language in 49.79(1)(a), 49.79(1)(b), 49.79(1)(d), 49.79(1)(e), 49.79(2)(a)1, 49.79(2)(a)3, 49.79(2)(a)4, 49.79(2)(a)5, 49.79(2)(a)5.a, 49.79(2)(a)5.b and 49.79(2)(a)5.c.

Id say all of (2)(a)

Effect of the Change

Removes the requirements that individuals cooperate with child support services as a condition for eligibility for FoodShare benefits.

Rationale for the Change

This change reduces barriers to program participation and provides individuals with a source of food through increased claiming of federal benefits.
