Technical Changes to the Transfer of the FoodShare Employment and Training Program

[LFB Paper #407]

Motion:

Move to modify the bill to specify that the 1.0 position that would be transferred from the Department of Workforce Development (DWD) to the Department of Health and Family Services (DHFS) for administration of the FoodShare Employment and Training (FSET) program would be afforded the standard protections usually afforded to state employees in this sort of transfer. In addition, reduce funding for DWD by an additional \$92,000 PR annually to reflect the actual amount transferred to DWD from DHFS for state administration of the FSET program.

This motion would make technical corrections to the Governor's proposal to transfer the FSET program from DWD to DHFS as discussed in Paper #407.

**ERRATA TYPE AND DIN TITLE OR SUBJECT:** Protection for position transferred from the Department of Workforce Development to the Department of Health and Family Services associated with the transfer of the Food Stamps Employment Training program.

**DESCRIPTION OF THE ERROR AND THE FIX:**

The budget calls for an end of the transfer of food stamp employment training funding from the Department of Health and Family Services to the Department of Workforce Development (DWD). Part of this provision eliminates 1.71 FTE administrative positions from DWD and creates 1.0 FTE at DHFS. The 1.0 FTE transferred, however, has not been afforded the standard protections usually afforded such positions in this sort of transfer.

The following language should be added to the budget as a non-statutory provision:

(a) Employee transfers.

1. 1.0 FTE classified positions, *and* the incumbent employee or employees holding this position, in the department of workforce development relating primarily to the functions of the Food Stamp Employment Training program is transferred to the department of health and family services.
2. The classified position, and incumbent employee or employees holding this position, in the department of workforce development relating primarily to general administration and program support that the secretary of administration determines should be transferred are transferred to the department of health and family services..

(b) Employee status. Employees transferred under paragraph (a) shall have the same rights and status under subchapter V of chapter 111 and chapter 230 of the statutes in the department of health and family services that they enjoyed in the department of workforce development immediately before the transfer. Notwithstanding section 230.28 (4) of the statutes, no employee so transferred who has attained permanent status in class is required to serve a probationary period.
