COMMERCE – WISCONSIN DEVELOPMENT FUND

Renewable Energy

Move to change the name of the segregated Recycling Fund to the Recycling and Renewable Energy Fund. Specify that the segregated fund be used for those purposes specified under current statute, as well as for the development, encouragement and promotion of renewable energy technology and usage in Wisconsin.

Move to create, under the Wisconsin Development Fund (WDF), a renewable energy grant and loan program to fund the development of new renewable energy technologies and provide \$15.0 million SEG in each year from the Recycling and Renewable Energy fund revenues for grants and loans. Further move to provide an administrative appropriation of \$50,900 in 2007-08 and \$57,800 in 2008-09, with 1.0 position to administer the grant and loan program.

The renewable energy grant and loan funds shall be used for the following categories of projects:

- (a) Provide \$5 million for the establishment of the first pulp and paper mill to be free of natural gas and coal usage. NS
- (b) Research and development, including demonstration projects, into renewable energy technologies;
- (c) Development of renewable energy sources and infrastructure in Wisconsin, including conversion from non-renewable to renewable energy sources;
- (d) Commercial application of renewable energy technologies; and,
- (e) Construction of a cellulosic ethanol plant(s).

Projects applying for a renewable energy grant or loan will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- (a) The extent to which the project will assist in the research, development or use of renewable energy sources in Wisconsin;
- (b) The extent the project will improve the competitive position of Wisconsin's renewable energy industry and/or build capacity in Wisconsin's emerging renewable energy industries;
- (c) Whether the technology or product is one which Wisconsin has a competitive advantage;
- (d) The likelihood of commercial application of new technologies or practices to the development, production, processing or distribution of renewable energy;
- (e) The extent in which the project will utilize excess or existing natural resources in Wisconsin;
- (f) The extent in which the project will strengthen Wisconsin's existing industries, e.g., by converting paper, food processing, printing industry waste streams into renewable energy; and
- (g) The extent in which the project will develop technologies to allow Wisconsin's manufacturing products to utilize renewable energy sources, e.g., engine manufacturers.

Where appropriate, the following factors would also be considered in evaluating projects applying for a renewable energy grant or loan:

- (a) Factors that would be considered in awarding other Wisconsin Development Fund grants and loans;
- (b) Whether the applicant is considered to be small, diverse, locally owned or a farm; and,
- (c) Geographical distribution of grants and loans.
